Law Forward Unveils New Website Exposing Bad Faith Behind 2020 Fake Electors Scheme To Overturn Presidential Election

Madison, WI - Law Forward, a non-partisan organization dedicated to protecting democracy, is proud to announce the launch of a [new website](#) aimed at shedding light on the nefarious origins and execution of the 2020 Fake Electors Scheme in Wisconsin. This website integrates the information learned through years of legal efforts and builds a timeline of events. Additionally, the site provides access to thousands of emails and text messages, as well as video, and photos obtained through the Penebaker et al v. Hitt et al. case, revealing the true extent of the scheme's deception and its connection to the events of January 6, 2021.

The documents demonstrate that the leaders of the scheme, Jim Troupis and Ken Chesebro, acted in bad faith. Despite claims to the contrary, their actions were not motivated by legitimate legal concerns but by a concerted effort to sow chaos and overturn the will of Wisconsin voters. From the inception of the scheme, their goal was clear: to keep Donald Trump in power at any cost.

"The launch of this website is a crucial step in holding those responsible for the Fake Electors Scheme accountable and ensuring that such egregious attacks on democracy never happen again," said Elizabeth Pierson, Staff Counsel, Law Forward. "By providing access to these documents, we aim to expose the truth behind the scheme and reaffirm the integrity of our electoral process."

The website features extensive documentation, including emails, memos, and texts, detailing the planning and execution of the scheme. Key revelations include:

- Chesebro's proposal of the fake-electors idea immediately after Biden's victory in Wisconsin.
- Plans to generate confusion and chaos to obstruct the electoral process.
- Deliberate efforts to undermine the legitimacy of the election results.
- Collaboration with national Trump campaign officials to implement similar schemes in other states.

Jeff Mandell, Co-founder and Board Member of Law Forward, emphasized the importance of condemning the Fake Electors Scheme and holding its architects accountable. He stated, "To downplay or excuse the actions of Troupis and Chesebro is to minimize the damage already inflicted on our democracy. Real accountability requires acknowledging the harm caused and ensuring that safeguards are in place to prevent future attacks on our democratic institutions."

The launch of this website marks a significant milestone in Law Forward's ongoing efforts to uphold the integrity of elections and protect the democratic rights of all citizens.
