Office of Lawyer Regulation Files Complaint against Michael Gableman, Taking Action on Grievance Filed by Law Forward

Today, the Office of Lawyer Regulation filed a complaint with the Wisconsin Supreme Court against Michael Gableman. The allegations arise from Gableman's extensive efforts to overturn the 2020 election at the behest of Robin Vos, Speaker of the Wisconsin Assembly. After Vos eventually fired Gableman, on March 2, 2023 Law Forward filed an omnibus grievance and hundreds of pages of supporting materials with OLR, asking that office to investigate and seek accountability for Gableman's numerous and egregious ethical lapses. In response to today's developments, Jeff Mandell, President & General Counsel of Law Forward issued the following statement:

"Gableman misused taxpayer funds, promoted baseless conspiracy theories, and engaged in improper intimidation tactics; his efforts undermined the integrity of our electoral system. Law Forward is committed to ensuring accountability for those who undermine the public's trust in our elections, and we will continue to pursue legal action to hold others who impugn elections responsible for their actions, ensuring that they face consequences for any misconduct that threatens the freedom to vote. Our work is far from finished, and we are dedicated to securing a future where elections remain fair, transparent, and free from interference."
